Based on the costs below, calculate the answer to each question.

# Approximate costs for SPCA to care for animals:



- \$25 will provide medical treatment for one injured animal.
   \$50 will keep an inspector's van on the road for one day.
- \$100 will allow us to spay/neuter, vaccinate, and microchip one cat preparing them to find their new forever home.
- \$150 will provide medical treatment and care for a litter of kittens and their mum.
- \$210 will give a puppy a warm bed for a week.
- \$500 will provide medical treatment and care for a litter of puppies and their mum.
- \$720 will provide dental care for six horses.
- \$1,000 will provide emergency medical treatment to a severely injured animal.

## **Questions:**

1. How long could an Inspector's van be on the road with \$700?
2. How much would it cost to spay/neuter, vaccinate, and microchip 15 cats?
3. How many weeks would a puppy have a warm bed for if someone donated SPCA \$1,680
4. How many animals could receive emergency medical treatment for \$10,000?
